

## Student Medical Insurance Information Website – Temporary ID cards and *Aetna Navigator*

Students enrolled in the Columbia Student Medical Insurance Plan have access to print a temporary insurance ID card through the Aetna Student Health website.

Instructions for printing temporary ID card:

- Go to [aetnastudenthealth.com/columbiadirect.html](https://aetnastudenthealth.com/columbiadirect.html)
- Click on **Print ID Card**
- Click on the applicable campus link (Morningside Campus, Teacher’s College, etc.)
- Follow the instructions at the top of the page and enter the requested information. For example, Morningside Campus students are asked to indicate their UNI and date of birth.
- Click on **View Card** and select correct ID card. Then click, **Print Card**
